### THE BREAKDOWN

- This framework will provide telecommunication services to the entire Public Sector, their associated bodies and agencies, the voluntary sector, and charities.
- The services available will consist of a range of primary and ancillary services, such as internet access, WiFi, radio, security and surveillance, audio and video conferencing, equipment, and maintenance and support services.
- This agreement is needed to help the Government and Department for Digital, Culture, Media & Sport achieve their ambitions with the Gigabit Project and the attempt to cover areas with poor or no connections.
- With the Public Sector's reliance on high-speed networks, the telecoms and digital infrastructure is unsurprisingly ever-changing.
